#### Winter Dismissal

**OUTDOOR:** For the safety of our children at dismissal, we ask that you not wait outside for your child. Students will be dismissed from the line walk in the front of the school. Parents are to meet their student at the sidewalk and escort to the car. It is very difficult to usher hundreds of kids outdoors when the lobby is full of parents. We appreciate your cooperation.

**INDOOR:** If the wind chill is below 19 degrees or if there is inclement weather, Indoor Dismissal may be called. Please wait in the lobby until Dismissal Time. Dismissal time for Kindergarten through 2nd grade is 3:25 pm. 3rd through 5th grade students will be dismissed at 3:10 pm.

#### Dress Code:

Our Dress Code is part of what makes Landmark Academy different. It is very important for the success of our school that all students are following dress code procedures. #### Parking Lot Procedures:

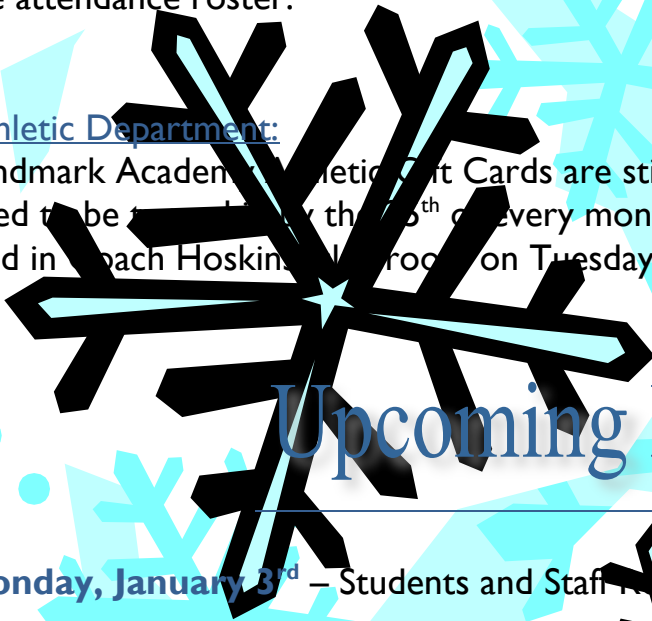


### Attendance:
