

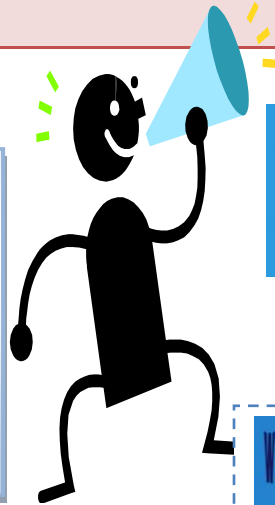

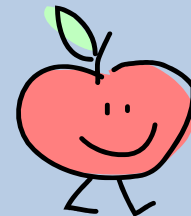

Lost and Found:

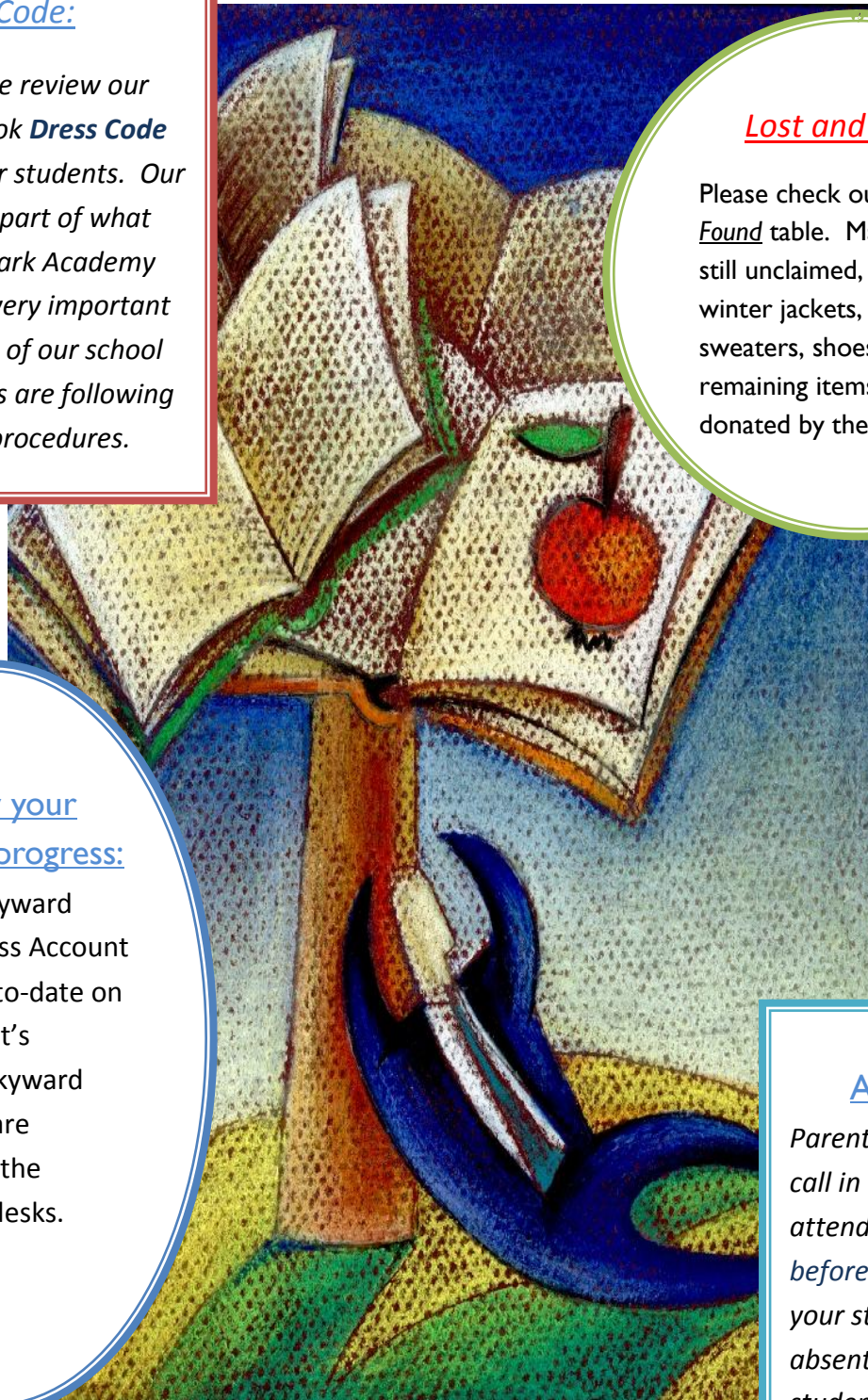

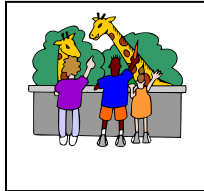

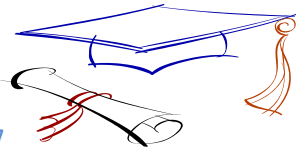
